### What are Network Scouts?

Network Scouts are for anyone aged between 18 to 25 years old. It is designed to bring young adults together socially and encourage them to push themselves to new limits. It is a chance for you to have a bit of fun, keep in contact with old friends and make new ones. There are opportunities to achieve your Duke of Edinburgh and Queen Scout Awards and become involved in section leadership. The programme is created for members, by members. If there is something you have always wanted to do, then Network is your place to do it. There is no Patrol structure, everyone has an equal status and therefore equal responsibility for organising activities and making things happen. There is a District Scout Network Leader who is responsible for recruiting and enrolling new members.

### What do Banstead Network Scouts do?

Currently, we meet every fortnight and each member takes it in turns to organise and run an activity.

### Does it cost anything?

Yes. It's £25 upon joining (which goes towards your scarf & badges when you are invested and also your Polo Shirt) then it is £35 per annum, which covers £10 capitation to the Unit and £25 Fundraising Deposit which they get back at the end of the year PROVIDING they have attended at least one Fundraising event. Each individual pays their own costs for any activities.

### Where does Network meet?

Our HQ is at Park Farm District Camp Site, Holly Lane, but we meet wherever it is convenient; if we are having a Planning meeting or discussion we may meet in a pub. Winter is more difficult as Park Farm is cold and very dark in the winter.

### Is there a uniform?

Yes. To become a member of the Network Scouts you will need to be invested. This means that you will need to get a uniform, but it's the same one the leaders wear, so if you become a leader, it gets paid for.

### How do I join?

The information on this form is input to Online Scout Manager, the online membership system we use to securely manage your child's personal information and badge records. Personal data will be stored on Online Scout Manager to support the application process and current and potential future involvement in Scouting. Some information is considered sensitive personal data and as such will be managed as required under the regulations. When the member is 18 years of age, information will be added to the Scout Associations Compass database system for recording roles, training and Disclosure records.

Where members take part in District/County Scouting events or where 3rd party event suppliers are used, this may necessitate the sharing of relevant information to support the planning and safe running of these events.

Ethnicity and religious information are requested by The Scout Association to help in monitoring its membership. The data will help the Association in understanding the makeup of the membership; monitoring progress against its inclusivity objective, and prioritising development work both nationally and locally, and will identify and help Leaders meet any specific needs of individuals. All information contained on this form may be shared with the Scout Association as part of their governance and insurance requirements.

Once the information has been added to Online Scout Manager, the form will be securely retained until you leave Scouting, when the form will be securely destroyed, and your electronic record deleted, or transferred to Scout Active Support Unit if they so choose to join.
